Some of our major initiatives in the area include:

2. Applying known methods and uniform industry measurements to publicly report on the company's water performance.
3. Regularly managing water risks, which helps the business' water management plans such as rainwater harvesting and usage of treated water for internal purposes.
4. To prevent the contamination of groundwater, surface water, and other water resources wherever practicable, we will practice zero discharge and treat wastewater before reusing it.
5. Ensure that facilities for storing water and recycled wastewater are built and maintained as per industry standards.
6. Recognize the water footprint left by our facility (if any) and strategize to keep a water balance that reduces the need for fresh water.
7. Reducing our ecological impact by maximising the use of natural resources, such as land and water, and by ensuring that water is used responsibly across all of our operations, including water conservation and increasing water efficiency.
8. Improving the security of the water supply in the communities where we operate.
